

Paths to qualification for LOCAL license:

NOTE: Effective February 28, 2019, the General Board decided that students who graduate from UPCI-endorsed colleges by the end of 2021 are exempted from the required reading.

OPTION ONE

1. Read the entire Bible, the current UPCI Manual, and all books on the local license required reading list.

2. Complete Ministry Central training series for local license level including both online videos and online tests (ministrycentral.com).

3. Meet all other qualifications and requirements in Article VII, Sections 2 & 3.



OPTION TWO

1. Read the entire Bible, the current UPCI Manual, and all books on the local license required reading list.

2. Complete any training course approved by the applicant's District Board which provides instruction and testing on all books on the local license required reading list. Such a program may test applicants independently or opt to use the online (Ministry Central) tests.

3. Meet all other qualifications and requirements in Article VII, Sections 2 & 3.



Paths to qualification for GENERAL license:

NOTE: Effective February 28, 2019, the General Board decided that students who graduate from UPCI-endorsed colleges by the end of 2021 are exempted from the required reading.

OPTION ONE

1. Read the entire Bible, the current UPCI Manual, and all books on the general license required reading list.

2. Complete Ministry Central training series for general license level including both online videos and online tests (ministrycentral.com).

3. Meet all other qualifications and requirements in Article VII, Sections 2 & 4, including having held local credentials for one year (or completed three or more years of Bible college).



OPTION TWO

1. Read the entire Bible, the current UPCI Manual, and all books on the general license required reading list.

2. Complete any training course approved by the applicant's District Board which provides instruction and testing on all books on the general license required reading list. Such a program may test applicants independently or opt to use the online (Ministry Central) tests.

3. Meet all other qualifications and requirements in Article VII, Sections 2 & 4, including having held local credentials for one year (or completed three or more years of Bible college).



For applicants who have completed three or more years at a Bible college endorsed by the UPCI, see Article VII, Section 4, paragraph 3.

Paths to qualification for ORDINATION license:

NOTE: Effective February 28, 2019, the General Board decided that students who graduate from UPCI-endorsed colleges by the end of 2021 are exempted from the required reading.

OPTION ONE

1. Read the entire Bible, the current UPCI Manual, and all books on the ordination license required reading list.

2. Complete Ministry Central training series for ordination level including both online videos and online tests (ministrycentral.com).

3. Meet all other qualifications and requirements in Article VII, Sections 2 & 5, including having held general credentials for two years.



OPTION TWO

1. Read the entire Bible, the current UPCI Manual, and all books on the ordination license required reading list.

2. Complete any training course approved by the applicant's District Board which provides instruction and testing on all books on the ordination required reading list. Such a program may test applicants independently or opt to use the online (Ministry Central) tests.

3. Meet all other qualifications and requirements in Article VII, Sections 2 & 5, including having held general credentials for two years.



For applicants who have been ordained by another church organization, see Article VII, Section 5, paragraph 4.
